Selectboard Meeting Minutes
Oct 20, 2014

In attendance: Bill Perkins, Chair, Burton Hinton and David Stevens, Selectmen, Greg Gallagher, Town Clerk, Gerald Saindon, Lister, Bruce Wheeler, Mariam Simonds, Paul and Cathi Wasklewicz.

Bill called the meeting to order at 6:05.

Burton moved and David seconded to add the following to the Agenda:

David asked if Greg knew what health insurance rates will be for 2015. Greg has a letter from Blue Cross which did not indicate much of an increase, but he will double check with Jacques Roberge, our health insurance consultant.

Greg explained that he has received an invoice from RC Contactors for the Long Pond Bridge for \$156,275, but there is still a process to go through before the State reimburses us. He would like to hold the check until they do.

Bill moved and Burton seconded that since they have done the work only hold the check for one week. Passed.

Financials were passed out.

Bill moved and David seconded to approve Select Orders and Payroll #21 and Corrected Select Orders #20 (with VT and IRS withholding). Passed

Bill reminded us that there would be a Trash/Recycling Meeting Oct 22nd at 6 PM with Paul Tomasi, NEKWMD and a State representative.

Gail Brown said the church is replacing their sign with one slightly bigger and would like the Zoning Application fee waived. Bill thought that a sign of that size did not need a permit, but was not sure.
