

Town of Westmore  
Selectboard Meeting Minutes  
Feb. 22, 2016

In attendance: Bill Perkins, Chair, and David Stevens and Burton Hinton, Selectmen, Greg Gallagher, Town Clerk, Chris Evans, Bruce Tanner, Phyllis Parrott and Mariam Simonds.

Bill called the meeting to order at 6:00.

Bill moved and Burton seconded to add the following to the Agenda:

- Multi-Sector General Permit (MSGP)
- Pavement Striping
- Town Highway Grants/Certificate of Compliance
- Dog Complaint
- Appraisal Redetermination and Stipulation
- Church Easement Request

Passed.

The MSGP was reviewed and will be filed. No action needed. Bill will call them.

Phyllis Parrott brought several concerns about her road to the Selectboard's attention. No grading, plugged culverts, lack of gravel, better ditching needed and a request to "pent" her road with an unlocked gate.

The Board will discuss some of these issues with Steve and the State at the upcoming Annual Meeting. These items will be reviewed again at the April 18<sup>th</sup> Selectboard Meeting.

Bruce Tanner talked to the Board about getting an easement for the Church across Minister's Settlement Lot for logging. The Board would like a release from the logger for crossing the bridge. The logger will be responsible for clean up when done. Bruce will discuss the process with his forester.

A barking dog complaint from Wally Rogers was reviewed. The Board asked Greg to forward the e-mail to the Sheriff for suggestions on what to do.

Chris Evans presented a Re-determination and Stipulation from PV&R.

Burton moved and David seconded to authorize Bill to sign the stipulation.

Chris informed the Board that Sunshine will not be seeking re-election at Town Meeting.

Chris, as "911 Coordinator, has been told by Newark that they will no longer be the First Responders for properties in Westmore, but much closer to Newark.

Burton moved and David seconded to have Bill talk to WF&R Chief, Chris McCarthy, to find out what this is all about. Passed.

Burton moved and David seconded to authorize Bill to sign the "Insignificant Waste Event Agreement". Passed. This has to do with the Hazardous Waste Day this summer at the Transfer Station.

Greg updated the Board on new regulations covering Food Scrap Collection starting July, 2017.

Residents will not be allowed to put food scraps in their garbage. It will need to be taken to the Transfer Station and dumped into a compost bin which NEKWMD will dispose of.

Burton moved and David seconded to have Steve deal with Highway striping, as well as Grant Compliance. Passed.

Greg will Warn a meeting on Feb 29<sup>th</sup> at 5 for organizational and Town Meeting updates.

Burton moved and David seconded to approve Select Orders and Payroll #4. Passed.

Burton moved and David seconded to adjourn at 8:18. Passed.
