Selectboard Meeting Minutes
March 20, 2017

In attendance: Bill Perkins, Chair, Burton Hinton, and David Stevens, Selectmen, Melissa Zebrowski, Town Clerk, Greg Gallagher, Assistant Town Clerk, Chris Evans, Lister, Wayne Mutrux, Surveyor, Katie Anderson, Jay Hudson and Miriam Simonds

Bill called the meeting to order at 6:00.

Burton moved and David seconded to add the following to the Agenda:

- Wayne Mutrux-Tower Lane
 - ATV use on Town Roads (Tabled from last meeting)
 - Excess Weight Permit-Amerigas
 - Odds & Ends
- Passed.

Wayne Mutrux reviewed information he has researched on boundaries of Tower Lane. He presented an aerial map/photo which showed where the road has been used. He suggested talking with an attorney to see if there is an “implied Right-of-Way” and to recommend the next steps for the Board to take.

ATVs on Town Roads were discussed, but the Board stated that no decision would be made until further legal steps have been taken to notify all concerned.

Bill Perkins stated that, if possible, he would like to see something done on the West Side as a trail (Lakeview, Cook and Wheeler Mountain roads).

Burton said that Fred, from VLCT’s insurance department has said that the liability for ATVs is not as serious as snow machines.

Katie Anderson said that summer residents should be made aware of what is being contemplated.

Greg had a number of letters and e-mails concerned about allowing ATVs on town roads. He will keep them in a file for later.

David moved and Bill seconded to approve Excess Weight Permits for Amerigas and United Natural Foods. Passed.

David moved and Burton seconded to approve Selectboard Minutes of March 6th. Passed.

Burton moved and David seconded to approve the March 7th Town Meeting Minutes. Passed.

Burton moved and David seconded to approve the Selectboard Organizational Minutes of March 7th. Passed.

Burton moved and David seconded to have Melissa Zebrowski added as a signatory, Greg Gallagher kept on and Michele Labounty removed from The Town’s Community National Bank’s accounts. Passed.

Burton moved and Bill seconded to approve a liquor license renewal for the Willoughvale. Passed.

Bill moved and Burton seconded to officers as before except to replace Greg with Melissa as Agent to Deed Real Estate and add Miriam Simonds as Fence Viewer. Passed.

Miriam reported that the March 3rd NEKWMD Meeting was canceled due to the snow storm.

Bill moved and Burton seconded to approve Select Orders and Payroll # 6. Passed.

The Board reviewed and initialed the Check Order List.

Greg passed out “Cash Reports”.

Correspondence was reviewed.

Greg will write to property owner Rahul Ratan about the trash rules. Someone from his property has been setting out trash in non-approved bags which have not been picked up and resulting in trash/garbage scattered all about.

Notice of Kingdom Games/Willoughby Swim was reviewed.

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Bill moved and David seconded to go into Executive Session at 7:37 on a Personnel issue. Passed.

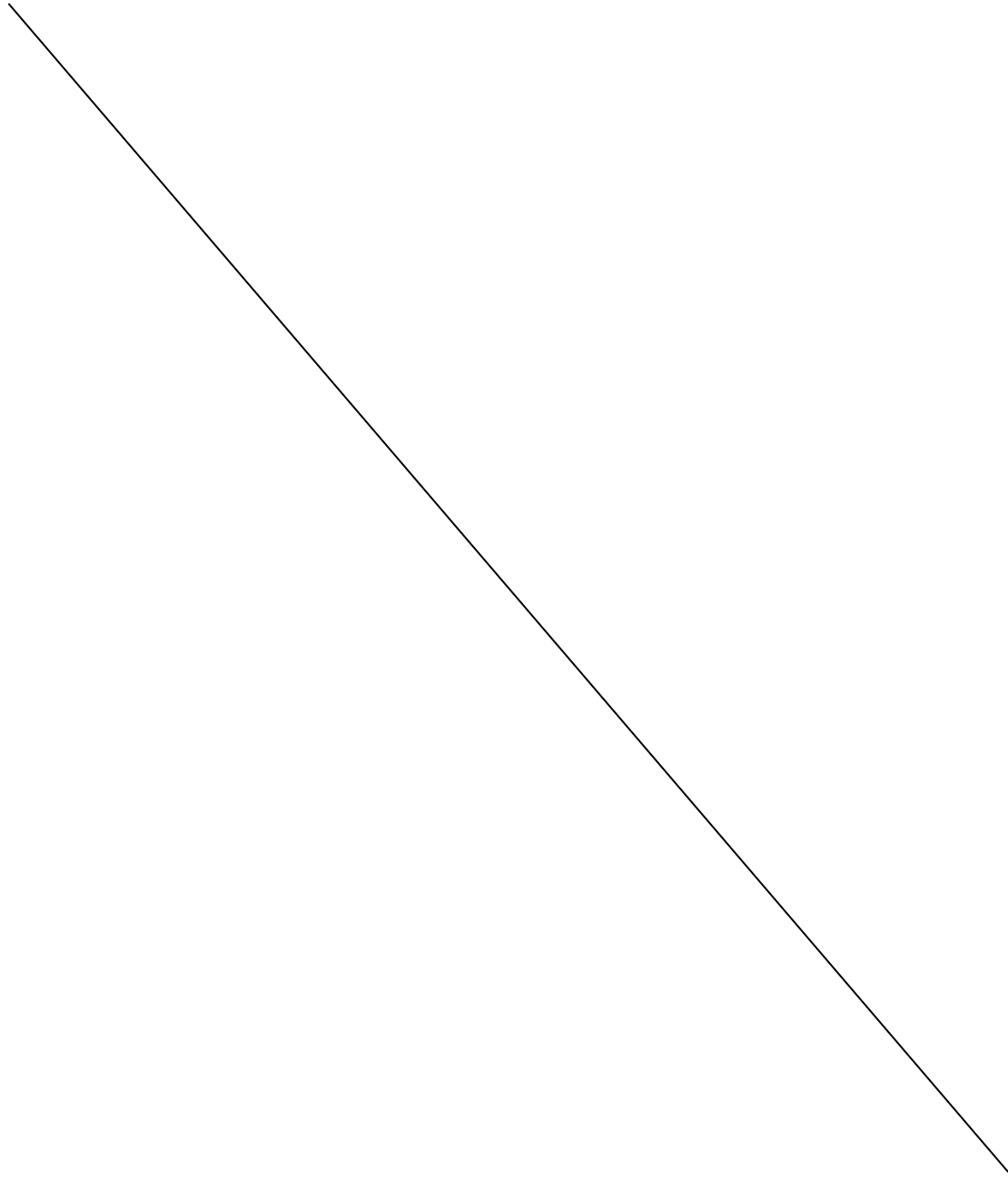
The Board came out of Executive Session at 8:15.
