Selectboard Meeting Minutes  
June 1, 2015

In attendance: Bill Perkins, Chair, Burton Hinton and David Stevens, Selectmen, Greg Gallagher, Town Clerk, Larry Phipps, Connie Lindahl, Jim Morin, Bruce Wheeler, Carol Davis, Miriam Simonds, Ann Duggan and Peter Hyslop.

Bill called the meeting to order at 6:00.

Bill moved and David seconded to add the following to the Agenda:

Burton moved and David seconded to approve the May 18<sup>th</sup> Minutes. Passed.

Burton reported that Alan Cole may ask for permission to run a power line under Hinton Hill Road. Steve's "Man Basket" is in.

Ann Duggan asked to have a site meeting with the Selectboard on issues with Old Cottage Lane. The Board will contact her when a consultant's report comes in and set up a meeting.

Larry, Connie and Jim discussed the new trash/recycle regulations.

After some discussion, Burton moved and David seconded to allow trash and recycling dropped off at the Transfer Station from 8-1 on Tuesdays (no curbside pickup), Thursdays and Saturdays starting July 2<sup>nd</sup> through the day after Labor Day, Sept 2<sup>nd</sup>. Passed.

Greg explained that Waste Zero had over produced our trash bags. Instead of 50 cases they made 75 Cases.

Burton moved and David seconded to order the 75 cases as we will need them eventually. Passed.

Burton will work with Paul Tomasi to create a recycling information brochure. Residents will be able to pick it up when they purchase the special garbage bags.

Greg will talk to Jim and Sandy Towns, Willoughby Lake Store, on how they plan to sell the trash bags.

Ray Lanier gave an update on the Greeter Program. He has five Greeters-three regular and two alternates. They have all been trained by ANR. One Greeter has already found Milfoil on a trailer coming out of the Lake. Ray is still looking for a location for a power washer to wash invasive species off boats and trailers. Ray has signs for kayaks. He asked if he could put one at the North Beach. The Selectboard said it would be alright.

Burton had to leave at 7:30.

Peter Hyslop brought his collection of various maps of Frog Hollow Lane. David had some as well.
